

# Universal settings

## Universal settings

Universal settings affect the whole program. It is worthwhile selecting each button in turn to explore the possible changes you can make.

Information buttons explain universal settings – as do the brief tool tips.

Only Numbershark administrators have access to *Universal settings*. If more than one administrator exists, they have equal status – and if any makes changes, these are made for **all** users, and they override any settings made in the *setting work* screen.

Several of the settings restrict students in ways that may be considered useful; see also in '**Setting work for students**' under the sub-title 'Enforcing set work, excluding games etc'.

- For students with **set** work, *Enforce set work* will restrict them to that only
- *Exclude games* can exclude individual games including reward games

Also under *Universal settings* there are a number of international display choices, for example £ sign alternatives and different operational signs, and also facilities for automatic sign-on.
